Treasury Report - Vaughn Dierks

See 2018 - 2019 Budget File (1/12/2019)

Expenses are as projected with a few exceptions
Fundraisers goal - bring in around \$2200 we came in close to goal
Advertising around \$1350 - we are budgeted for \$2000 revenue
Tech dinners are hurting the budget - we are not getting the revenue to help cover the expenses.

We need student revenue to help offset the expenses

What should we do with the line item \$500 collected from the haunted hayride? It was meant to offset tech dinners. Discussed and agreed to reallocate hayride funds to ITF show for Kaitlen's mentor stipend.

Kaitlen:

New this year all participants will be charged \$10 (crew) - \$15 (performers) to participate in HSM, ITF show - this will go into the Thespian account to help offset costs of the show

Spring Fundraiser Musical:

- Jordan (Assistant Director) and Joe Pedro (Stage Manager) came to the meeting to talk about the Spring Fundraiser Musical "High School Musical"
- Budget:

Royalties \$2145, mentor advisor (Kaitlen) \$1000, \$650 for set (per tech director) - because the set will be 2 level, \$50-100 props, \$250 costumes, hair, makeup (jerseys etc...) \$4095, \$1950 - \$2000 from Footlights

Who pays for rights (school or footlights?) Usually the school pays for rights - Look at borrowing jerseys from other productions

- Kaitlen there is a thespian account for the ITF show. Part of the haunted fundraiser can pay for the mentor advisor. Half was budgeted to Footlights
- Luann please spread the word for props to see if the community can help provide them.

Scripts are available 2 months before opening night of the show.

Budget for Spring Musical from ITF:

Vaughn - we currently have \$750 budgeted

Dan - motion to approve \$750 for expenses for props, costumes, set for HSM, Luann second.

Cathy will email Daley and let her know that Footlights approved \$750 for HSM and she should submit receipts to us for reimbursement (up to \$750). We will also let the team know to contact us if they have other needs (for costumes, props...) We may have "stuff" or talents that can help.
